

Janesville Community Health Center Fact Sheet



What is the Janesville Community Health Center?

The Janesville Community Health Center (JCHC) is a partnership between Mercy Health System and Community Health Systems, Inc. JCHC provides health care services for Medicaid, underinsured and limited uninsured patients in Rock County. Eligible patients can receive primary care at a reduced rate, as well as low-cost prescription drugs.

JCHC provides:

- Preventive medical care for infants, children, adults and seniors
- Gynecological care
- Obstetrical, prenatal and well-baby care
- Family planning
- Immunizations
- Diagnostic tests and screenings
- Sports physicals
- Day care physicals
- Treatment for depression and other mental health issues
- Some laboratory services
- Home visits
- Discounted pharmacy program

Who is eligible to receive care?

Medicaid patients covered by the MercyCare Medicaid plan and people with no health insurance are eligible to participate. The amount of discount is based on a sliding fee scale in relationship to the patient's income level and family needs. **Patients must provide a financial history and complete an application prior to seeing a physician.**

How soon can I see a physician?

Generally, patients can be seen by a physician within a week. **Patients must first call JCHC to make an appointment with a financial counselor.** Physician appointments are scheduled shortly thereafter.

JCHC is located within Mercy Clinic South, 849 Kellogg Ave., Janesville. This facility is just east of Center Ave. (Hwy. 51), and conveniently located near two Janesville Transit System bus stops: Center Avenue at the Rock County Job Center and the intersection of Lafayette and Conde Streets.
